Student Aid Fund (SAF) Application Information 2022-2023 School Year Immanuel Lutheran High School

Dear Parents of Immanuel Lutheran High School Student,

The Student Aid Fund (SAF) provides four types of financial aid for ILHS students: Student Loans, Work Study (Campus Jobs), Income Based Grants, and Scholarships. Many of you have not submitted applications in the past, as the programs do not fit your particular situation. A new High School Tuition Assistance program has been created within the SAF that applies to all students. This program will help offset the need for a larger than normal increase in tuition, an increase that is necessary due to our anticipated reduction in enrollment. Therefore, we ask that all submit an application.

The enclosed packet includes an informational brochure and application form. The **completed application** form **for the 22-23 academic year** must be returned to the Immanuel Business Office **by May 1, 2022**. If your application is not received, we will assume you decline the new Tuition Assistance. It is preferred that you return your application and indicate that you decline, rather than have no response. If you accept the Tuition Assistance, but do not provide family income information, you will receive the lowest grant level. Written notice of SAF awards will be made by June 30, 2022. Note that SAF academic scholarships are awarded based on the previous school year's GPA while attending Immanuel. No application is needed to receive an SAF academic scholarship award.

It should be noted that the tuition and fees indicated represent preliminary costs for the 2022-2023 ILHS school year and may be subject to change. For a dorm resident student, the maximum requested student loan is \$6,000 (70% of a student's total annual billing). For a non-dorm student, the maximum loan amount is \$3,500 (70% of a student's total annual billing). A student account must be in good standing (not delinquent) in order to receive additional loans.

The Student Aid Fund exists to provide financial assistance for Immanuel parents and students. We welcome the opportunity to assist you in your financial planning and in considering various options for the funding of costs associated with your child's attendance at Immanuel.
